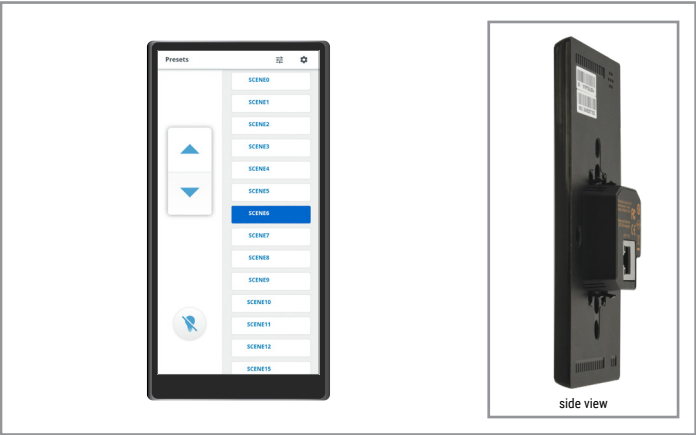

Overview

The WaveLinx TSE57 touchscreen provides an elegant and discreet light control for any WaveLinx controlled space. The portrait-oriented 5.7" [14.5cm] touchscreen features a low-profile design with edge to edge glass and an extremely responsive display making it a great architectural addition to conference rooms, executive offices and open spaces.

Product Features & Benefits

- **Light control** – Control the lights for a room/open space by allowing users to recall the light scenes/presets defined for the area and to raise/lower the light level for the entire area or the zones defined within an area.
- **Architectural design** – Low profile design with edge to edge glass and high resolution display making the touchscreen look amazing on any wall. The touchscreen's user interface has been designed to ensure that users can immediately understand how to operate the touchscreen.
- **Easy installation** – The touchscreen easily mounts in a single gang switch box (minimum 1.4" / 35mm depth required) and is powered via PoE (IEEE 802.3af). Once powered, all the installer has to do, is select the WaveLinx Area Controller (WAC) discovered on the network and one of the user defined areas. All the information with regards to the scene names, zone names is automatically imported from the WaveLinx Area Controller .

The touchscreen is an accessory to the WaveLinx connected lighting (WCL) system and requires a WaveLinx Area Controller (WAC) for full functionality.

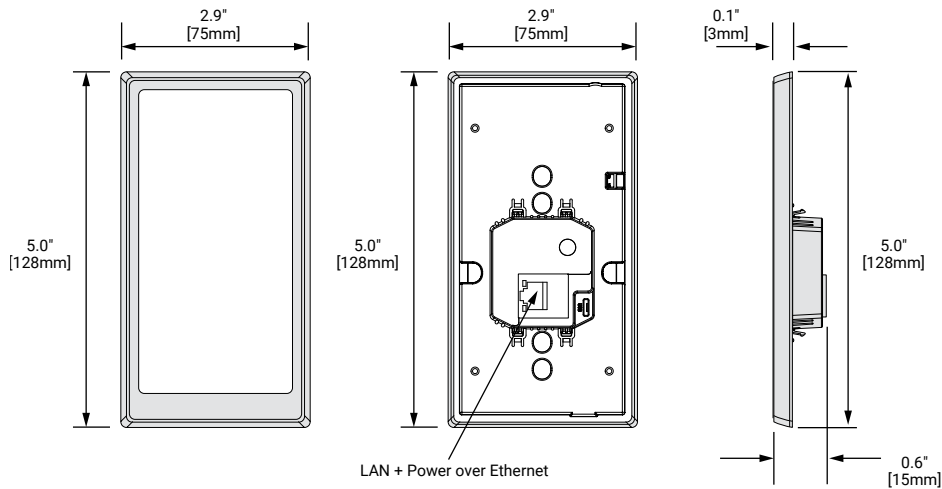

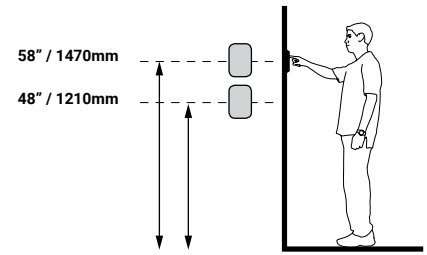

Mounting Height



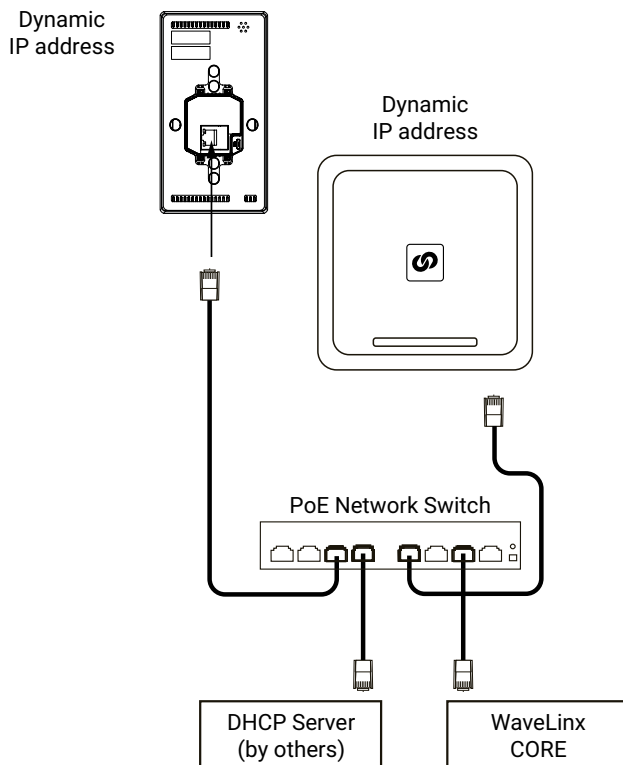
Installation

- Connect the Touchscreen to a POE network switch via an ethernet (CAT5 or higher) cable using the RJ45 port on the rear of the touchscreen
- The Touchscreen flush mounts in a portrait orientation to a single-gang switch box
- Do not mount on metal surface
- Use the Settings menu (PIN protected) on the Touchscreen for setup, i.e. associate it to a WaveLinx Area Controller and select one of the areas configured on the selected WaveLinx Area Controller

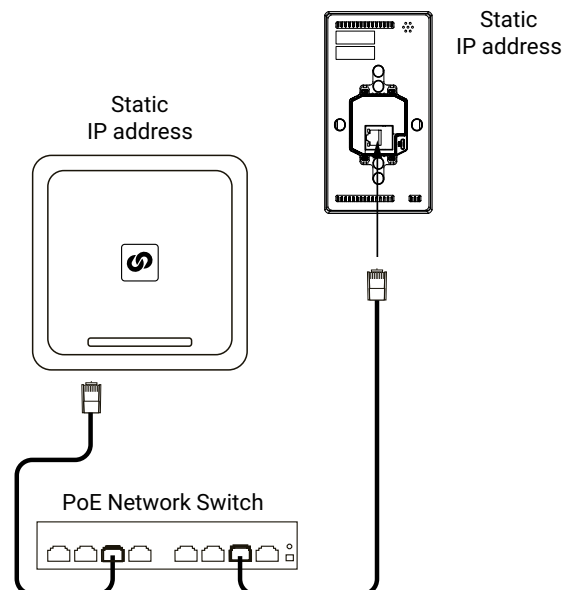

System Diagram:

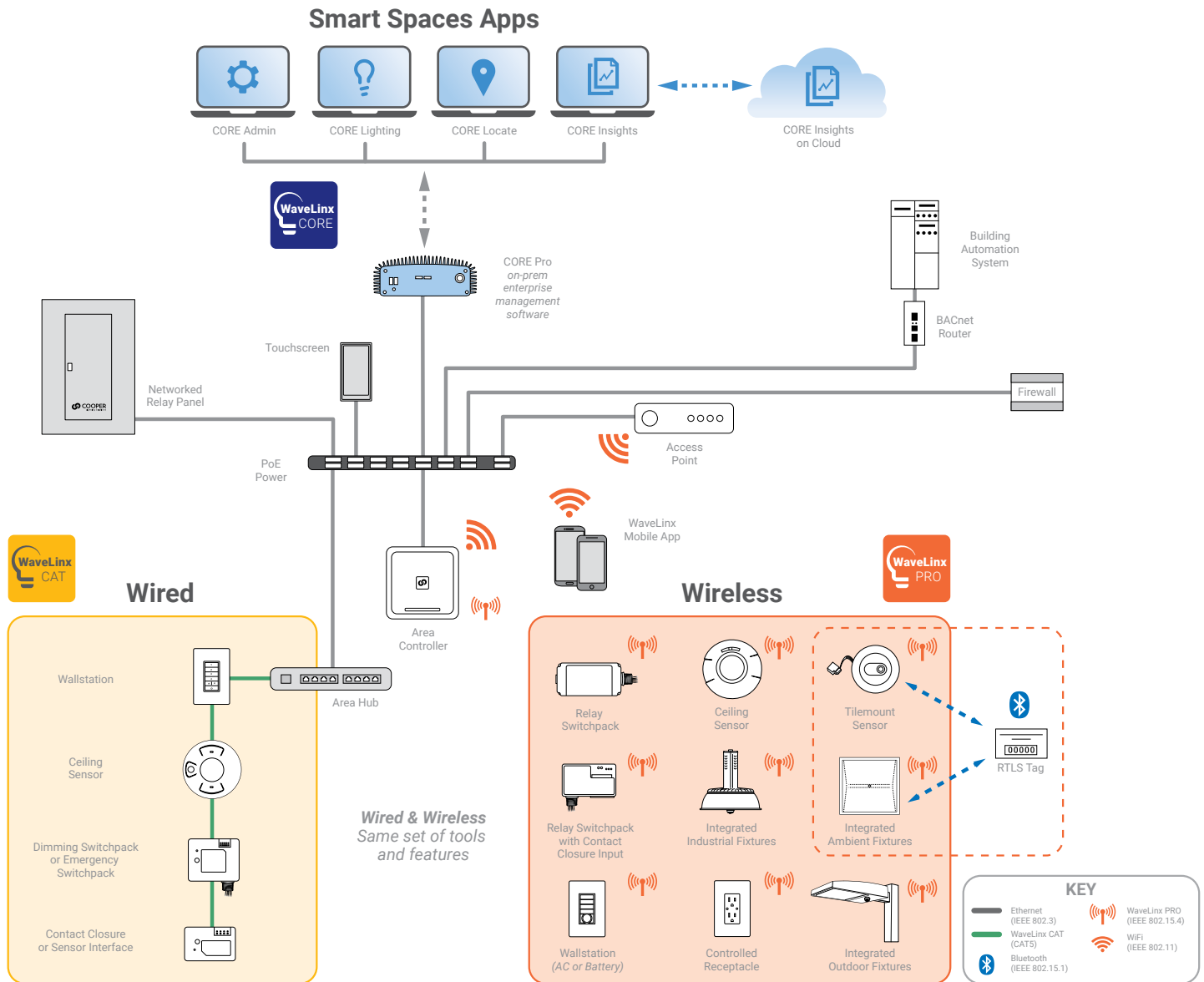
This diagram shows the main components of the WaveLinx connected lighting system with CAT and PRO devices.


The PRO devices communicate using wireless mesh technology based on the IEEE 802.15.4 standard. A PoE LAN connection for each WaveLinx Area Controller (WAC) is required for power and data access to the building lighting network.

The CAT devices communicate over the category 5 based communication bus and control the light fixtures using a relay (on/off) and 0-10V output (dim/raise).

WaveLinx Area Controllers (WAC) communicate with WaveLinx CORE Apps over the Ethernet network.
